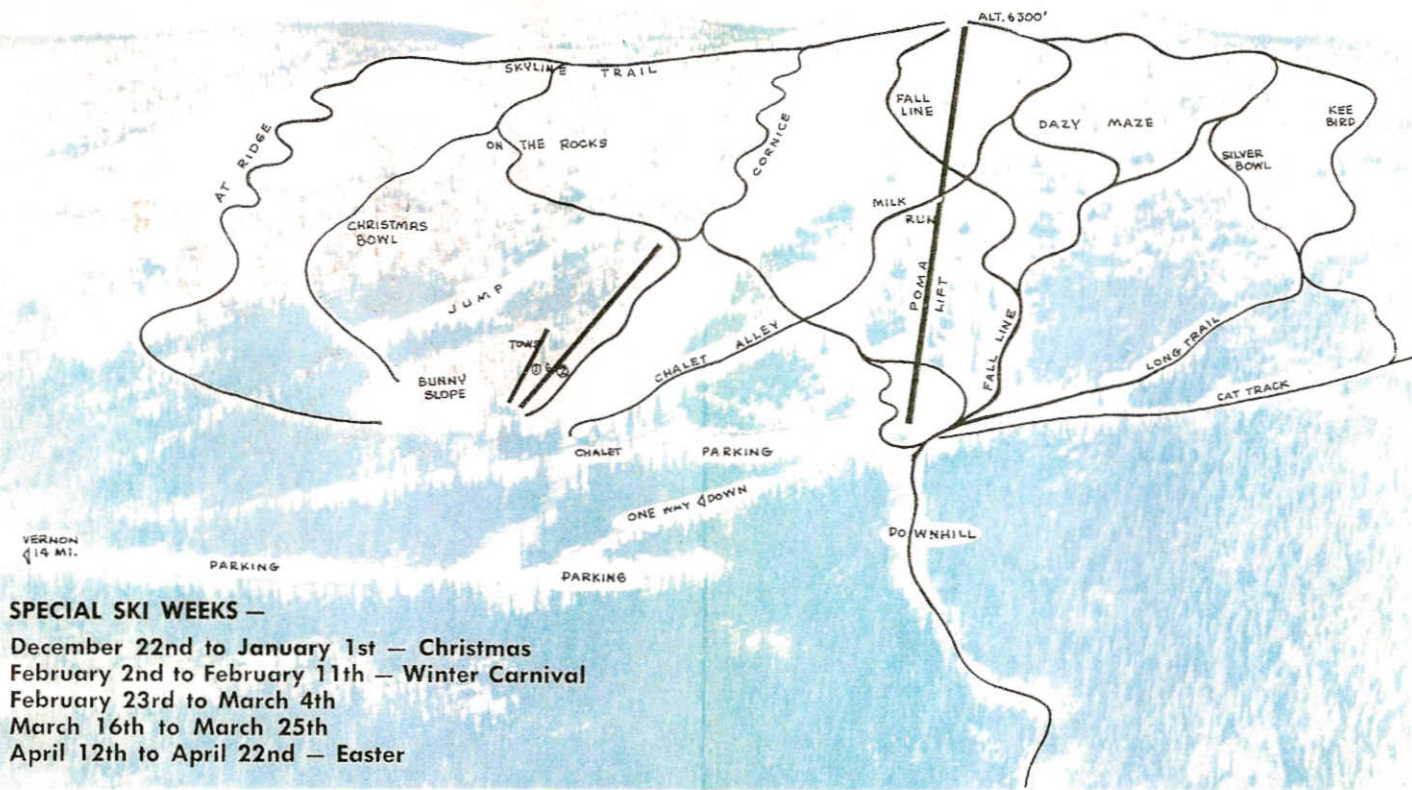

Vernon's Silver Star

Less than 14 miles from Vernon, rising majestically from the northeast, are some of the most spectacular mountains within the British Columbia interior. Silver Star Mountain, on the threshold of the rugged Monashee Range boasts one of the longest ski seasons in Western Canada — with powder snow measured in feet rather than inches, lasting from mid November until mid May. With the summit extending to over 6,200 feet above sea level, blue skies and sunshine are the rule rather than the exception.

Silver Star Ski Area is served by a 2,400 foot Poma Lift (1,100 per hour), an intermediate tow and a "bunny" tow. The day Chalet has cafeteria, sport shop, locker room and rest room facilities. A large open fireplace will delight skier and sightseer alike. Lifts operate every Saturday, Sunday and Monday; Christmas and Easter weeks and during the Vernon Winter Carnival. New trails have been developed and existing trails widened. There are a wide variety of slopes for all types of skiers — beginner to expert — and powder for the deep snow enthusiast.
