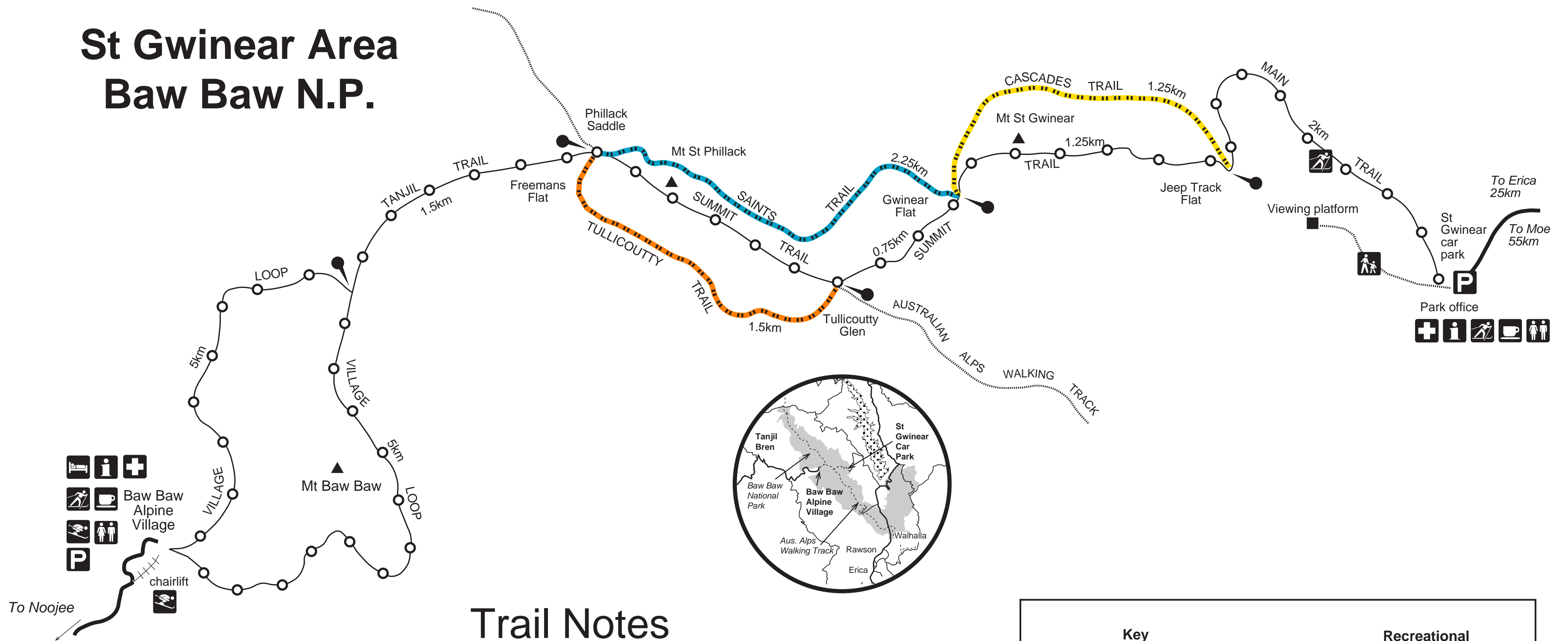


St Gwinear Area Baw Baw N.P.



Trail Notes

St Gwinear and the Baw Baw Alpine Village are linked by a permanent pole line of treated pine poles. **Orange arrows** on these poles indicate the direction to the next pole

The **Main Trail** gives access to the plateau area. Coloured stakes mark alternative loops linked to the permanent pole line. These loops are only marked during the winter period.

Cascades Trail (Yellow poles) : traversing under Mt St Gwinear, this alternative to the Summit Trail, will help those returning tired, late or caught in bad weather.

Tullicoutty Trail (Orange poles) : one of the most pleasant runs on the plateau – recommended route in preference to the permanent pole line (Summit Trail).

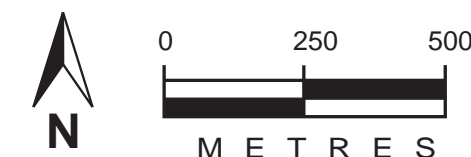
Saints Trail (Blue poles) : intermediate skiers will enjoy the long downhill run from the Plateau's highest peak to Gwinear Flat.
